The 13th edition of the International Visual Theatre Festival Tallinn Treff brings together a wide-ranging, multifaceted programme: 13 productions from abroad (Finland, Germany, Italy, Denmark, Belgium, Netherlands, Israel, England and Slovenia) as well as local outstanding examples of visual theatre and arts. The carefully curated selection includes performances for all age groups, including (small) children, young and adult viewers.

The festival, having evolved into a key local meeting place for contemporary puppet, object, material, physical, and multimedia theatre, continuously seeks an inspiring dialogue between content and form, traditions and innovation. Most of the productions have no text or are performed in English. Performances take place at the Estonian Theatre for Young Audiences as well as in various other locations of Estonia's charming capital Tallinn (see map for directions).
